- Just For Kicks soccer classes are specially designed for children in 3rd through 5th grade to improve their individual skills, technical abilities and team tactics. By participating in a variety of soccer exercises and fun activities, the players will learn the proper techniques of passing, dribbling, shooting, and heading. In addition, the program boosts the players' confidence with the ball, encourages sportsmanship and instills a love for the game.
